



FIRE SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of Southern Cranes and Access Ltd, so far as is reasonably practicable, to ensure that responsibilities for Fire Safety and Training are assigned, accepted and carried out at all levels throughout the Organisation. To ensure that all practicable steps are taken to safeguard the health, safety and welfare of all Employees, Contractors and Visitors to the premises or operations under our control.

It is therefore our intention to:

- To maintain proper provision for fire precautions, fire fighting and systems for evacuation in the event of any emergency.
- Provide appropriate provision of medical and related facilities to safeguard health and welfare of all employees.
- Maintain records to allow Fire Safety performance to be measured.
- Encourage through consultation, the co-operation and involvement of all employees in achieving those objectives.

All employees are therefore expected to:

- Take responsible steps to safeguard themselves and any other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions whilst at work on company business.
- Report any potential hazards, which in turn may be a fire risk to their Line Manager. Any advice and training will be sought from company approved Health and Safety/Training bodies.
- Co-operate with the organisation, so far as is necessary to enable any duty or requirement imposed on Southern Cranes and Access Ltd, by relevant statutes to be performed or complied with.

It is recognised that Southern Cranes and Access Ltd. operate in a dynamic environment and therefore this policy will be reviewed periodically in light of future developments.
